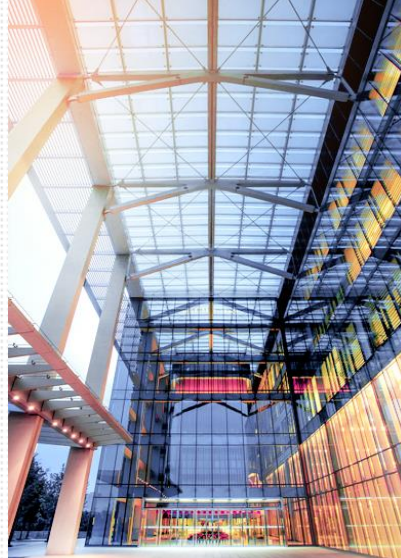

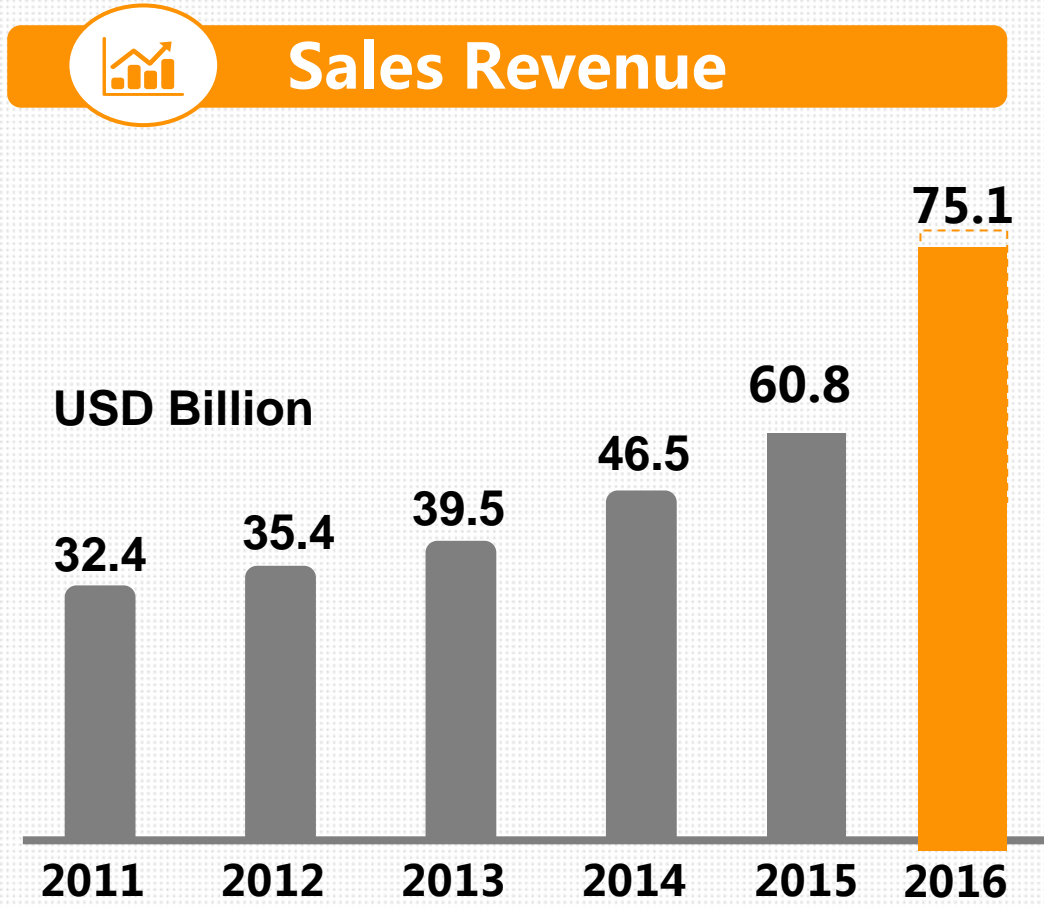

- Supporting operations of 1,500+ networks globally, serving over one-third of the world's population in 170+ countries and regions.

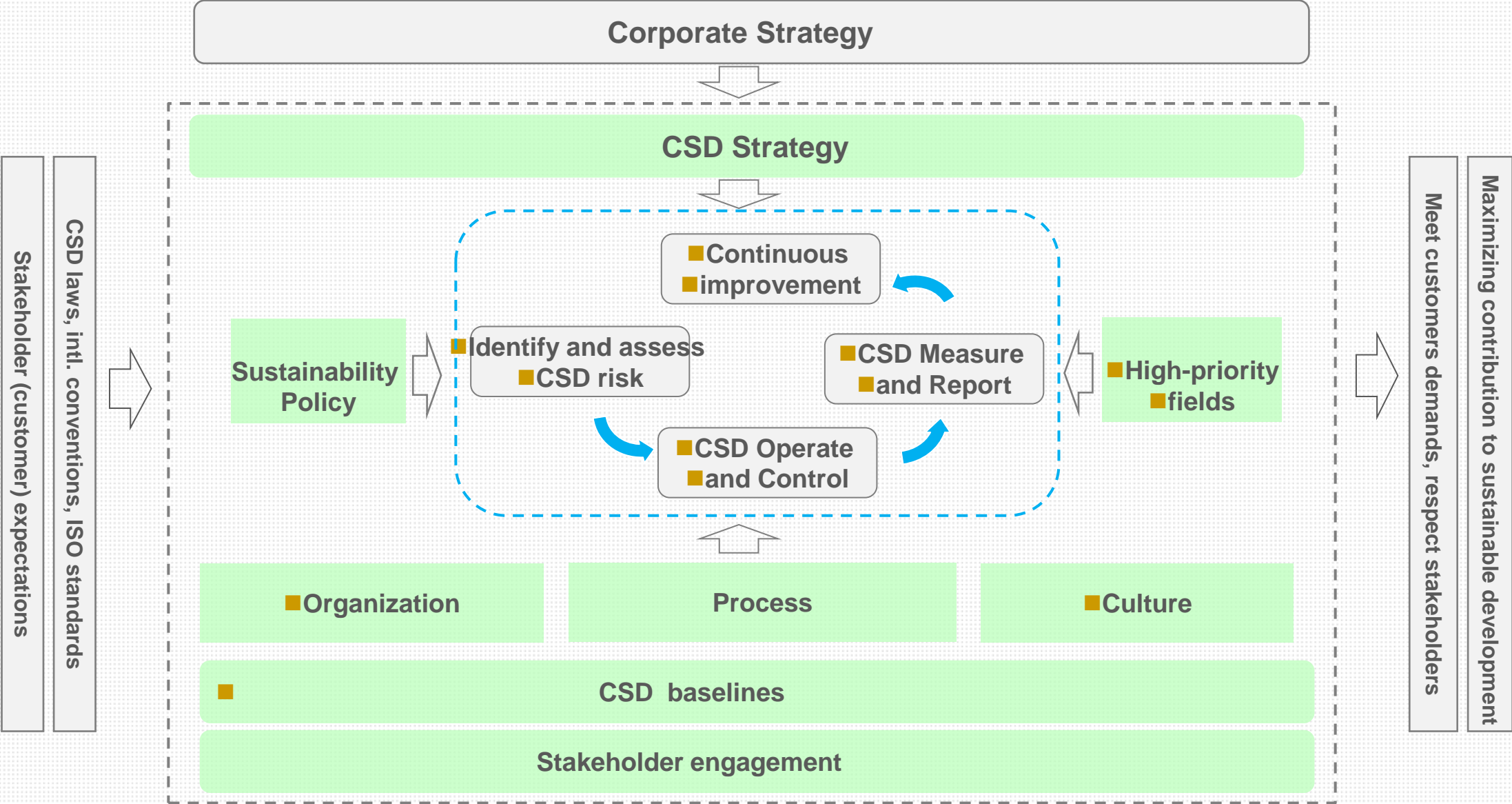


- Safe City solutions serving about 400 million people in 100+ cities across 30+ countries in the Middle East, Africa, and Asia-Pacific regions.

Hungary CSR



Background: 10 students + 1 professor from Hungary have the possibility to study the Chinese culture in Beijing and the most advanced ICT technology in Shenzhen HQ annually. Totally **55 persons** travel to China during this period. The Hungarian program has the value of **300 K USD** for 5 years .



Established in 2016

Background: Huawei Hungary signed a Memorandum of Understanding in the presence of H.E: Péter Szijjártó, the Minister of Foreign Affairs and Trade with the University of István Széchenyi (Győr) to establish a **Huawei Laboratory and Academy** to contribute to the Hungarian higher education.

The volume is approx. **300 K USD.**
